Affirmative

I / You / We / They	live work study	in London.
---------------------	-----------------------	------------

Negative

I / You / We / They	don't	live work study	in London.
---------------------	-------	-----------------------	------------

Yes/No questions

Do	I / you / we / they	live work study	in London.
----	---------------------	-----------------------	------------

Short answers

Yes,	I / you / we / they	do.
No,	I / you / we / they	don't.

Wh- questions

Where	do	I / you / we / they	live? work? study?
