A chant containing key words from the unit provides opportunities for repetition and reinforcement.

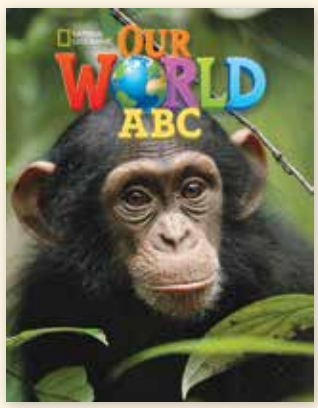
The unit ends with a fun game that continues at the back of the book, where students can also complete a Picture Dictionary with that unit's words.

A funny, illustrated story reviews the sounds and spellings from the unit in an engaging context.

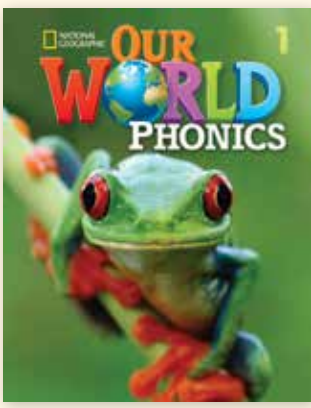

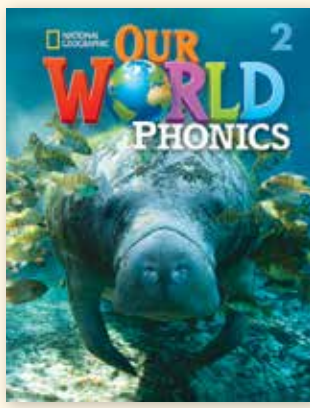

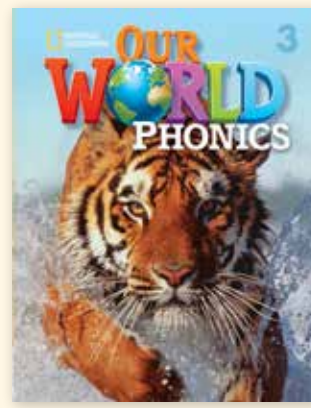
*Our World ABC* introduces and practices the letters of the alphabet, numbers, shapes, and some high-frequency words.
