# Unit 4 Animals on the Farm

LESSON 1 Theme Introduction Student Book pp. 30-31

### Objective

**Identify and name:** chicken, cow

## Warm Up

- Wave to children and say Hello! Have them wave and say *Hello!* back to you.
- Have children sing the **Hello Song** (Audio: TR 2 / Video: Routine) as they wave hello to each other.

### Make Connections

• Show the dog. cat. rabbit. fish. *turtle*, and *bird* picture cards one at a time and say These are *animals.* Then hold up the *dog* picture card and ask What is this? If children need more support, ask Is this a dog? (yes) Then hold up the *cat* picture card and ask *What is this?* Continue until you have reviewed all of the Level 1 Unit 7 picture cards.





- 3 Introduce the Theme
- Bookwork Help children open their books to pp. 30-31. Sav Let's learn new words for animals. Show the photo on p. 30. Say This is a farm. Say These are farm animals. Point to the chickens on p. 30 and then to the other farm animals on p. 31.
- Slowly show Picture Cards 103–108. Don't say the words for the animals.

Video Option Show children the vocabulary presentation of farm animals on the video without playing the audio. Use Video: SC 2.

#### 4 **Teach the Vocabulary**

• Bookwork Show children the photo on p. 30 again. Point to a chicken and sav *A chicken*. Then point to the photo of the chicken on p. 31 and say again A chicken.

- Make the sound of a chicken and walk around like a chicken. Say I'm a chicken. Point to children and say *Be a chicken!* Have students make the sound of a chicken and walk around like a chicken.
- Show children the *cow* picture card. Repeat the activity, showing children how to make a cow sound and crawl around on their hands and knees.
- Say Listen! Play Audio: TR 32 while showing the picture cards for chicken and cow. Have children repeat each word two times.

Video Option Show children the vocabulary presentation of the words *chicken* and *cow* on the video. Use Video: SC 2.

• Say Let's listen to a chant. Play the Unit 4 Chant (Audio: TR 33). The first time, have children just listen. Hold up the *chicken* picture card for the part about chickens. Then hold up the *cow* picture card for the part about cows.

- Play the chant again. Have children move like the animal they hear. Even if they can't chant all the words. have them make the animal sounds.
- Play the Transition Song (Audio: TR 3 / Video: Routine) as you give a copy of Worksheet 2.4.1, scissors. and a black and a brown crayon to each child.
- · Worksheet Hold up the worksheet, point to each picture, and ask What is this? (chicken, cow)

#### 5 End the Lesson
