## Objective

Demonstrate understanding of:
chicken, cow, horse, donkey. duck, goat

- Say Hello! or Hi! to each child Encourage them to greet you and each other using Hello! or Hil
- Ask children to sing the Hello Song (Audio: TR 2 / Video: Routine)
- Say the full Unit 4 Chant (Audio: TR 41) with children.
- Show Flashcard 58 (a cow) and ask Is this a farm animal? (yes) What is it? (cow) Place the flashcard face up, where children can see it.
- Show Flashcard 53 (a turtle). Ask Is this a farm animal? (no) Ask Is this a farm animal? (no)
Good! It's not a farm animal. It's turtle. Place the flashcard face up, starting a different pile.
- One by one, repeat this activity with the other Unit 4 flashcards. Ensure you put all of the farm Ensure you put all of the farm

## Practise the Vocabulary

- Review the colours brown, black and white Show chidren Flashcard 48 (black). Ask What Flashcard 48 (black). Ask What
colour is this? Then ask children to find and point to things in the lassroom that are black. Repeat his activity with the colours brown and white.
- Bookwork Help children open Bookwork Help children open
their books at page 32 Point to their books at page 32. Point to his? Ask Is it white? (no) Then ask What colour is it? (brown) Point to the next horse and ask again What colour is this horse? (brown) Point to the matching horses and say Yes! This horse is brown. This horse is brown, too! Let's circle it! Model circling
he matching brown horse in the middle column Tell children to circle the brown horse
- Point to the last horse and ask Is this horse brown? (no) Say That's right. It's not brown. Don't circle it!
- Point to the first cow and ask What is this? Then ask What colour is it? (black and white) Point to the second cow and ask What colour is this cow? (brown and white) Then point to the third cow an ask What colour is this cow? (black and white) Say Yes! Point to the cow on the left and say This the cow on the right and say This cow is black and white, too! Let's circle it.
- Point to the first chicken and ask What is this? Then ask What colour Is it? (White) Now you themselves to find and circle the matching chicken Walk around the room, providing help as needed.


## Language

Review: black, brown, chicken, cow, donkey, duck, goat, horse, white Recycle: bird, cat, dog, fish, rabbit, turtle
Receptive: Is this a farm animal?; What is (it/this)?; Good! It's not a farm animal.; What colour is (it/this horse)?; Is it (white)?; Yes! This (horse) is (brown), too.; Let's circle it.; This cow is black and white

Teaching Tip
Whenever possible, use your voice and clear and strong gestures to help children understand your words. For example, while saying a sentence strongly and shake your head from side to side. Or use whatever gesture means 'no' in your culture.

Tell children to sit in a circle on the floor. Put all of the farm animal flashcards in the middle. Say Look! Then tell children to turn around so that they can't see the cards. Remove one of the cards nide it. Tell children to turn around and try to work out which farm animal card is missing.

- Give each child a set of Unit 4 mini flashcards. Ask each child to choose three cards from his or her set and place them facing up. Call out words one by one. (Keep track of the words you call out.) When a child hears you say a word on one of his or her cards, the child should turn over that min their cards over should call out 'Bingo!'
