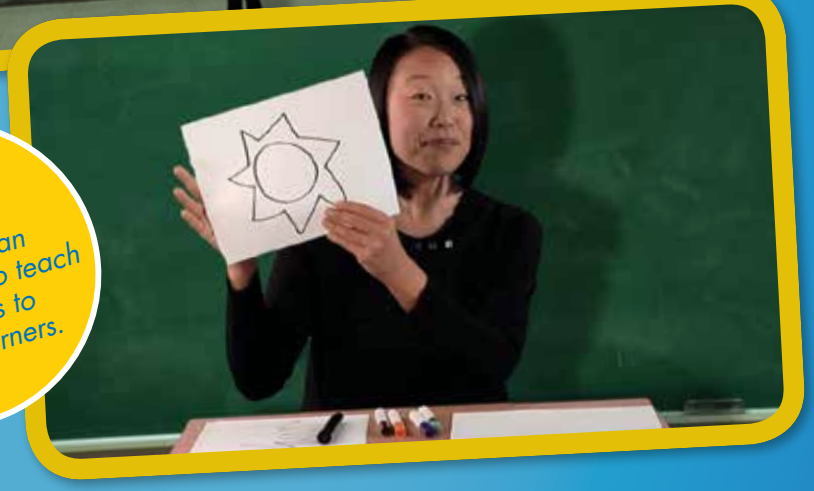

Dr. Joan Kang Shin

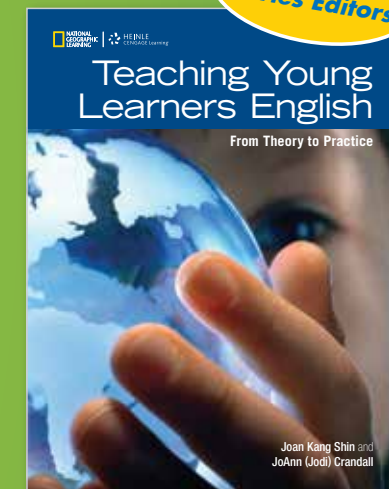
