

































The audio program contains recordings of the full text of each reader—including the Expansion Readings.



Learners can use the audio recordings before, during, or after they read, as a model of pronunciation and intonation and to improve their general listening skills.

Suggested listening activities, for use with the audio CDs, are included in the Teacher's Manual.



The Footprint Reading Library brings the stories to life with stunning videos from National Geographic Digital Media.

Video is available for each title in the *Footprint Reading Library*. The length of each video clip ranges from 3–13 minutes, according to its level of difficulty, and includes a closed caption option.

The videos are designed to be used alongside the printed readers or on their own (supported by photocopiable materials in each Teacher's Manual). Scripts for each video are included in the Teacher's Manuals.

















