visualize verb	to make a picture in your mind	When I am homesick, I visualize my mother cooking in our kitchen.	
image noun	a picture you make in your mind	I often have an image in my mind of my mother cooking.

Reading Strategy

Visualize

When you **visualize**, you make an **image** of something in your mind. You also think about what you hear, taste, smell and feel. **Visualizing** helps you enjoy the story more.

As you read “My Korean Name,” **visualize** the story.

1. After you read each paragraph, close your eyes. Make **images** in your mind of people and things in the story.
2. Look at each paragraph again. Find the words that helped you **visualize** the paragraph.
3. Look at the chart. After you read, you will look at the reading again. Then you will complete the chart.

Word Connections

visualize (imagine, reflect, contemplate)
image (picture, representation, reflection)

Have students use **Word Webs** to show relationships between the Word Connections.

- **Preview** The Academic Vocabulary words are highlighted throughout the chapter so students can easily find them in context.
- **Use the glossary** *Say: The Glossary is found at the back of the student book.*
- **Vocabulary development** Ask students to visualize something they often do. Have them describe what that image looks like.
- **Use alphabetic order** Remind students to add Academic Words to their Vocabulary Logs in alphabetical order.
- **Paired discussion** Have student pairs compare their drawings and sentences.
