





It is called the Quadracci Pavilion and it was considered so great that Time Magazine named it 'Best Design of 2001'. This is because it is not only beautiful, but useful as well.

In the Quadracci Pavilion, there are two enormous 'wings' which open and close twice a day. It takes 3.5 minutes for them to open or close.
